The NAAA Warren Young, Sr. Scholastic Foundation, Inc. makes 12 scholarships available each year to eligible NAAA-member auctions and corporate office full-time employees, their children, stepchildren and grandchildren.

Available Funding

Twelve Scholarships totaling \$52,000 are awarded each academic year:

- Four \$3,000 Scholarships – 2-year school or auto-related degree at a vocational/technical school
- Eight \$5,000 Scholarships – 4-year school

Eligibility Requirements

Applicants must be:

- Full-time U.S. or Canadian employees, employed as of the date of notification at North American National Auto Auction Association (NAAA) member auctions or corporate offices, and their children, stepchildren, and grandchildren.
- High school seniors or graduates who plan to enroll, or students who are already enrolled in a full-time undergraduate course of study at an accredited two- or four-year college or university, or who are pursuing an auto-related degree at a vocational/technical school.

Selection Process

- Consideration is by merit, not financial need
- Selection made by a third-party firm, Scholarship Management Services
- Consideration includes: past academic performance and future potential, leadership and participation in school and community activities, work experience, statement of career and educational aspirations and goals, unique personal or family circumstances, and an outside reference.

Application Procedure

- The first 200 applications received will be reviewed
- **Applications must be submitted within the deadline:**

November 15, 2014 – February 1, 2015
